Learning in Fifth Grade!

Keicher fifth graders have been busy working on establishing routines, learning locker combinations and adjusting to classroom life.

Our fifth grade scientists have been working on thinking like scientists and have been creating inventive ways to engineer and design arches.

The historians recently finished a unit on geography and map skills. They learned how to create a map of their own country, read directions on a map, locate points on a map using latitude and longitude, as well as identify the hemispheres different countries are in.

Fifth grade mathematicians are just finishing a unit on place value. They reviewed tenths, hundredths and thousandths. Students have also been rounding numbers and working on order of operations.

The writers in fifth grade have been working on drafting and writing personal narratives. We have been using events from our lives and creating writing pieces. We have focused on adding dialogue, the author's point of view, and using correct grammar and punctuation.

Readers in fifth grade are building stamina, choosing "just right" books and making their way through our NWEA assessments and yearly reading (Fountas and Pinnell) assessments.
